Recently, Pennsylvania has started the Safe2Say Something (S2SS) program in all schools across the state. This program is a reporting system that students can use to report any warning signs or threats regarding school or student safety and/or wellbeing. Students who report using this system are ANONYMOUS, meaning that they cannot be identified as the one who made a report. This is done to protect their privacy. Students can make reports by phone or online using the S2SS website or S2SS app, which can be downloaded on any device.

As a school in Pennsylvania, NativityMiguel School will also start using this system. Two presentations will be held for each grade, one talking about identifying and notifying about warning signs and threats and the other one teaching students how to use the S2SS system. These presentations will be held on the following days:

Presentation 1 (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades): Friday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> at 2:00pm

Presentation 1 (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades): Tuesday, February 26<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm

Presentation 2 (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades): Friday, March 1<sup>st</sup> at 2:00pm

Presentation 2 (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades): Tuesday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm
