- If you need a chromebook, the school will provide you with one. Contact Mr. Casey as soon as possible.

- **As far as we know at this point, the 8th grade will be attending the SPARK program at the University of Scranton during the week of July 20-24.** More information will be provided as the dates draw nearer. Students attending the SPARK program will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the University of Scranton.
- 8th graders will be given additional assignments for the summer. Ms. Polcino and Ms. Kresge will let students know what these assignments are at the beginning of the summer program.

Please mark your calendar and make every effort to ensure your child is on time for this program and in attendance each day. **The Summer Program is an integral part of the NativityMiguel experience and helps our students to be adequately prepared for academic success in high school and beyond. Any student who does not attend the summer program, or whose attendance is deemed unsatisfactory, may be ineligible to re-enroll at NativityMiguel the following year.** We are grateful for your support.
